

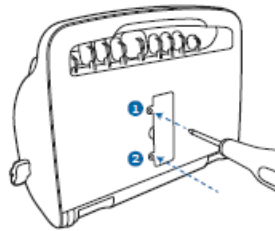
Please find a replacement battery for the SMART Braille enclosed. We discovered a problem with a shipment of SMART Braille batteries that we received from our vendor and it is possible that you received a SMART Braille with a battery that does not charge properly. To rectify the problem, please replace your SMART Braille's battery with the new battery enclosed.

How to Install the Battery

Warning: Do not plug in the braille until the battery has been installed. To avoid risk of personal injury, do not install the battery if it is damaged.

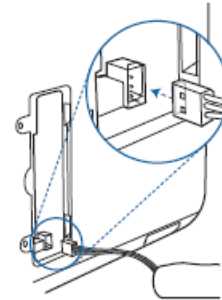

Locate battery door on bottom, unscrew the two screws and remove door.



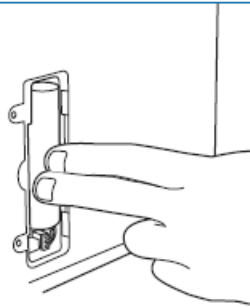

Connect battery power plug in the right corner of the battery compartment. The plug fits into the port in only one way.



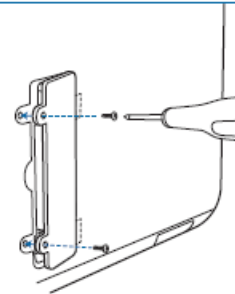

Once connected, place the battery in the compartment and hold in place.



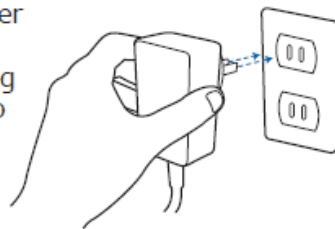

Close the battery cover, first inserting the tabs into the slots on the right. Screw the two screws back in place.



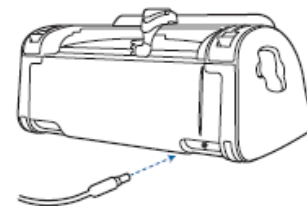

Locate power adapter in box and plug adapter into wall power socket.



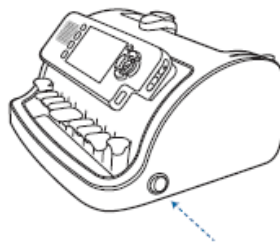

Plug adaptor cord into its port at the left rear side of braille.

Turn on the braille using the switch on the lower right side. Listen for the beep.

Wait 40 seconds for the software to load. When you hear "Welcome Guest" you are in the Welcome Menu.



Fully charging the battery should take no longer than 8 hours. You can use the SMART Braille while it is charging. When charging is complete, the charging icon on the screen will go away.
