1 Camera: Rotate for multiple purposes

2 Power: Short press to power on or put on standby, and long press to power down

3 & 4 Color mode: Move up or down through color modes

5 Capture: Press to capture or return to Live view


6 & 7 Magnification: Increase or decrease zoom level

8 LCD screen: Touch to select



Button Bar Menu

- Main Menu button top left corner of the screen, tap to open more options.
- Volume and Speech Rate button middle left of screen, tap to open the sliders that control how loud and fast Juno speaks.
- Restore button bar bottom left of screen, tap to restore and hide the button bar menu.
- Lights on button top right corner of the screen, tap to toggle lights off and on.
- Line & mask button middle right of screen, tap to display reading line and mask drag one finger to move line or mask boundary.
- Lock focus button bottom right, tap to turn on and off focus lock to use during writing or hobby tasks.




Reading Settings

How to use System Settings

Time and Date

• Set the date and time that the system displays in the upper right corner. If the battery fully discharges, then you will need to reset the date and time.

Default Save Types

• Select the default file type used when capturing pictures and the default file type used when capturing text.

Update Juno

 Update Juno with the latest software and firmware. For any future updates download the latest Juno software onto a USB-C flash drive to update Juno. You can use the same flash drive to update multiple Juno devices.

Reset to Defaults

• Reset the device to the default values. All customized settings are lost, including the volume, speech rate, brightness level, and voice selection. However, the menu voice, date, and time are saved.






Discoveries
