



Updates to Reading and Math Tools on the MATT Connect

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Learning Objectives

- The participant will
 - Understand the basics of the Books and Notes applications, as well as their purpose.
 - Recognize and appreciate the ability to bookmark and annotate reading materials.
 - Identify the steps to set one of the three available calculators as the default.

Know that user data can be shared and how to turn sharing on and off.





Challenges

- Students need a way to identify and review key information in text such as new vocabulary words or themes.
- Different students require different ways of annotating text.
- Navigating back to an important passage in a long text can be difficult for students using magnification.
- Completing paper worksheets can create a barrier to learning.
